³ If we put bits into the mouths of horses so that they obey us, we guide their whole bodies as well. ⁴ Look at the ships also: though they are so large and are driven by strong winds, they are guided by a very small rudder wherever the will of the pilot directs. ⁵ Likewise, the tongue is a small part of the body, but it makes great boasts.

•The tongue is <u>D_____</u>.

.....Consider what a great forest is set on fire by a small spark. ⁶ The tongue also is a fire, a world of evil among the parts of the body. It corrupts the whole body, sets the whole course of one's life on fire, and is itself set on fire by hell.

•The tongue <u>C</u>.


• James is saying that an evil tongue is set of fire by <u>S</u>himself.
