⁴Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything. ⁵ If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously to all without finding fault, and it will be given to you. ⁶ But when you ask, you must believe and not doubt, because the one who doubts is like a wave of the sea, blown and

tossed by the wind. ⁷ That person should not expect to receive anything

from the Lord. ⁸ Such a person is double-minded and unstable in all they

do.

⁵ If any of you lacks wisdom, you should ask God, who gives generously

ASK

AITEO means: To ask in the sense of:

 \rightarrow R

★ Matthew 7:9-10

⁹ "Which of you, if your son **asks** for bread, will give him a stone? ¹⁰ Or if he **asks** for a fish, will give him a snake?

\rightarrow D

★ Luke 23:23

²³ But with loud shouts they insistently **demanded** that he be crucified, and their shouts prevailed.

\rightarrow P

★ Matthew 21:22

²² If you believe, you will receive whatever you **ask** for in prayer."

 \longrightarrow **AITEO** emphasizes that the prayer is for something to be \underline{G} rather than for something to be \underline{D} .

ASK GOD

★ Proverbs 3:5-6

⁵ Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding;

⁶ in all your ways submit to him, and he will make your paths straight

ASK GOD IN FAITH, WITHOUT DOUBTING

 \longrightarrow Faith is \underline{E} in approaching God.

★ Hebrews 11:6

⁶ And without faith it is impossible to please God, because anyone who comes to him must believe that he exists and that he rewards those who earnestly seek him.

DIDOMI means: gives

The word is in the present tense which means that God is C giving.

"It is characteristic of the unbeliever to see God with a clenched fist; it is characteristic of the believer to see Him with an open hand."- John Blanchard

HAPLOS means: liberally, with singleness of heart. As an adjective it means simple or single.

 \longrightarrow God gives with a single motive: to further the \underline{W} of the asker.

ONEIDIZO means: to assail with abusive words, to insult, to slander, to falsely accuse or to speak disparagingly of a person in manner not justified, to find fault in a way that demeans the other, to mock, to heap insults upon as a way of shaming.

>→ It means to upbraid , which in turn means to <u>C</u>	severely,
find fault with, reproach severely or scold vehemently.
